

FIRE-SERVICE ORDERS DORMITORY

STUDENTS, VISITORS, GUESTS ARE LIABLE FOR KEEP THE FIRE SERVICE ORDERS CONCERNING
THE DORMITORY.

Orders for the rooms of the dormitory

- a) Activities in the rooms are not allowed (e.g. cleaning the clothes with flammable fluids, experimenting with chemicals, etc.) which cause fire or detonation.
- b) Using hot-plate, radiator or warming-pan in the rooms is not allowed.
- c) When leaving the room, radio, television and any other electrical devices (even PC) connected to the electrical network have to be shut down.
- d) Placing decorations and any other flammable matters on lamps and cables are not allowed.
- e) The emplacement of the furniture in the room ensures the flight. The change of the furniture's position is not allowable.
- f) Smoking and the using of naked light is not allowed in the rooms. Smoking is only allowed in the signed places.
- g) It is not allowed to place or pile up materials beyond fixtures and personal objects, materials needed for the living and the ordinary lifestyle.
- h) It is very important to avoid to boost the rooms' flame-loadability and in case of fire and the danger of quick evacuation.

General information in case of fire

- a) Detecting inchoate small fire it is the duty of every roomer to rake out the fire with the stand-by fire extinguishers and equipments in the building.
- b) You mustn't fight the fire on electrical devices with water before switching-off!
- c) If the fight of the detected fire needs help, the fire has to be signaled.
- d) The possibility to give a signal in case of fire is ensured in the dormitory. You can find more manual fire-alarms on the corridors on every floor, using them the siren activates, which alarms the dormitory's reception. Noticing the fire-service is their task.
- e) If human life is in danger, its rescue is the primary object /Call the Ambulance on mobile phone or from the reception on the number of 104, from the rooms 0104/.
- f) When the fire-alarm siren activates, the people in the dormitory have to leave the building over the stairways (the elevator in this case is not functioning).

Every fire (even the fought ones) has to be reported to the fire-service agent by the dormitory's managing committee.
