

FIRE SAFETY POLICY

1. Abiding by the University of Pannonia's Fire Safety policy, and the Dormitory's Fire Safety Policy is mandatory for any dormitory residents, and anyone who uses the dormitory's services.
2. Any activity, that may result in fire, or explosion, or bodily harm to anyone is forbidden on dormitory grounds.
3. The use of electronic cooking appliances, cookers, grills, toasters, immersion heaters, etc. inside living blocks is forbidden. Only items in impeccable condition, and that abide by Hungarian Standard can be used.
4. The electric razor's plug can only be used in accordance with regulations.
5. The use of open flames in the room is forbidden. Smoking is only allowed in the allotted, outdoor area.
6. Dumping the contents of the ashtray, or throwing smoldering cigarettes in the wastebasket is forbidden.
7. The use of electric heaters in rooms is forbidden.
8. Lighting appliances can only be used in a way in which they cannot start fires. Flammable decoration material cannot be placed on lighting appliances.
9. The obstruction or narrowing of walking or escape routes is forbidden even temporarily.
10. The placing or hoarding of any furniture, and personal items or materials not required for dormitory living or a normal lifestyle is forbidden. The increasing of the living block's fire load, and the risk of fire evacuation has to be avoided at all costs.
11. In case of a fire, the reception, and the Resident Assistant on duty has to be notified. The dormitory residents have to be alerted, the building has to be evacuated in an orderly manner. The building has to be vacated through the corridors and the stairwells outdoors, the emergency exits have to be used.
12. A wet cloth can be placed in front of the face to avoid smoke poisoning. Visibility is better near the ground, so to improve orientation the escape has to be done in this position if the need arises.
13. In case of Fire Safety Rule, or Fire Safety Policy violation, Dormitory management can issue disciplinary action, compensation, fire departmental penalty.
14. When noticing smaller fires, the dormitory resident is obligated to use the fire extinguisher in the corridor, or the wall-mounted fire hose to douse the fire.
15. Electric fires can only be extinguished by water if the appliance has been taken off the electric grid.
16. Fire alarms are available in the dormitory. Intelligent fire alarm appliances, and manual fire alarms can be found. Starting any of these sounds the siren, the fire-retardant doors close automatically (can be opened with the doorknobs), the reception is alerted along with the fire department after a delay.
17. In case of fires the dormitory residents have to vacate the building via the stairwells (the elevators will automatically go to the ground floor and open their doors).

Any fires (even the extinguished ones) have to be reported to the Dormitory Director.
