

**DORMITORY INFORMATICAL POLICY**

1. The informatical network of the Dormitories is part of the University of Pannonia's informatical network. In accordance with this, the users of the dormitory's network have to abide by the University of Pannonia's informatical policy.
2. The use of the Dormitory network is only allowed to those with a valid Dormitory Living Contract, after endpoint registration.
3. The right to use the Dormitory network cannot be transferred to anyone else, the service cannot be forwarded to anyone, this includes forwarding with good intentions.
4. Any liability caused by faulty processes, illegal or forbidden activity is the responsibility of the registered owner of the usage right.
5. Rights of the user:
  - a. Respecting personal rights and privacy of letters by the network's operators.
  - b. The opportunity to request protection against harassment.
6. Connection and transfer can only be initiated to permitted service ports on the Dormitory's network. Usable services are: http, https, ftp, ssh, telnet, telnets, whois, finger, pop3, pop3s, imap, imaps, auth, nntp, ntp, rsync, cvs, svn, dict, mysql, google talk, postgresql, yahoo aim, msn, skype, sip, irc, x11, xfs, dict, rdp, bitkeeper. The use, or attempted use of any other service is forbidden. These services can only be used on ports outlined in the IANA (<http://www.iana.org/>).
7. The usable services are regulated by the Dormitory's network router. Bypassing the rules, or attempts at bypassing the rules are disciplinary offenses.
8. Connecting, and running services on student-owned active- or passive network equipment (eg. switch, cshub, access point, etc.) can only be done after previous arrangements, and permission from the administrator. The operation of DHCP servers is forbidden in every case. Network address translation (NAT) is forbidden in every case.
9. Only services permitted by the administrator can be ran on student computers.
10. The use of the dormitory's network for private matters pertaining to the student's basic activities (eg. personal e-mails, personal website) is available in a limited amount. The use of the dormitory's network for business purposes is forbidden.
11. The preparation or execution of acts violating hungarian laws is forbidden. These include, but are not limited to: violation of others' personal rights (eg. religious-, political- or ethnic discrimination), unlawful gain, or business activity (eg. pyramid schemes), the violation of copyright, and neighbouring rights (eg. illegal use, and spreading of softwares), any activity going against canons of good taste (eg. spreading of pornographic material), etc.
12. Lending, or transferring usernames and passwords, and the use of these, even with the permission of the owner is forbidden. Not using the network as intended, compromising it's security and operation, or any activity that can cause the aforementioned issues (eg. spam, portscan, etc.) or spreading of such programs, wasteful and unnecessary overuse of resources is forbidden.

13. It's forbidden to unnecessarily disturb or hinder others' work in an excessive manner. Furthermore the unauthorized modification, damaging, or termination of network resources, data or services is also forbidden.
14. Using the network resources or services for anything other than their intended use is forbidden.
15. Interception or falsifying of network traffic is forbidden.
16. It's forbidden to access, use the network's resources and data, use the computers/services for testing (eg. TCP port scan). Breaching attempts or cooperating in such is also forbidden.
17. Every member of the network is obligated to adhere by the internet ethics policy (<http://www.mek.iif.hu/porta/szint/muszaki/szamtech/wan/kultura/rfc1855h.hun>).
18. The dormitory resident is obligated to report any rule violations to the administrator responsible for the dormitory.
19. The dormitory resident accepts, that the operators of the network may collect data for technical or security reasons.
20. The dormitory resident accepts, that the operators of the network may restrict their access for a set time, or permanently if they notice any use of the network that does not adhere to the rules.
21. The dormitory resident states that they know and accept the validity of these rules.
22. The dormitory resident accepts, that if they violate the dormitory informational policy, they are eligible to be placed under faculty disciplinary action.

In case of any other questions, the Administrator Resident Assistant responsible for the Veszprém campus can give answers.

This policy is active starting June 8, 2024, until it's recalling.
